

Medication management for your upcoming procedure scheduled with Dr.Woo/Dr.Tesfaye

Medications:

1. Avoid NSAIDs for 7 days prior to your procedure.
2. If you are taking blood thinning medications for stroke,heart or blood clots, please consult with your Physician before your procedure.
3. Always take your blood pressure medication even on the day of your procedure with a little sip of water.
4. If you take diabetes medications, take a ½ dose of your medications. You must discuss the management of these with your endoscopist or your prescribing physician ahead of time to decide on the timing of the doses.
5. If you are taking phentermines these medications need to be stopped 5 days prior to your procedure.
- 6. If you are taking GLP-1 receptor agonists (Ex: Ozempic, Wegovy, Rybelsus,Saxenda,Victoza,Trulicity,Byetta,Bydureon,Tanzeum,Adlyxine) these medications need to be stopped 1 week prior to your procedure.**

You may take your morning medications with a little sip of water the day of your procedure.
